On the 11th April last we forwarded a box of Tobacco to the above Consignee, to Enniscorthy Station, but as it was lost during the Rebellion, we beg to apply to you for the necessary Form to enable us to lodge a claim for the amount.

We made a claim upon the Railway Company on the 2nd June last, immediately we had ascertained the loss, but with the exception of their official acknowledgment, we did not hear anything from them until we raised the matter again on the 30th September last. We then received a call from a representative of the Company, who suggested that we should apply to your Committee for compensation. As, however, ~~we~~ ^{then} had no proof that the goods were lost during the Rebellion, we thought our claim lay against the Company, and he agreed to refer the matter back to them. We had not heard anything further from them until we now receive a letter dated the 4th inst. in which the Company inform us that they decline our claim, and refer us to you.

We regret very much the great delay which has taken place, but we believe you will agree from the correspondence that there has not been any carelessness on our part, and in the circumstances we trust you will be able to facilitate us in the matter. The amount of our claim against the Company was for £4:8:7, particulars of which we enclose herewith.
