Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 4th instant I beg to say that on the 15th June, 1916, the Property Losses Committee was appointed to report to Government on claims for property lost or damaged in connection with the disturbances in Ireland in April-May 1916, and notices appeared in the press calling on all who had suffered loss to send in their claims to this office. The 13th August was fixed as the latest date for receiving intimation of claims.

As the Committee are now winding up their work they cannot accept any fresh claims. If, however, in the four cases in which you are interested claims were lodged for hearing at Quarter Sessions, and you will write to me to this effect at once, giving the date of such lodgment, it will be seen whether claims can now be entertained by the Committee.

his horse & Cart to his Brother John Farrell  
to go to Galway to bring a ton of Flax to  
Loughrea (no strain being running at the time,

accompanied by Farrell's man, they were met  
on the public road by a crowd of men  
who seized the horse & Cart & Harness Flax  
and all & made prisoners of the driver and took  
him to Moyad Castle. All the Harness was  
destroyed or damaged in such a way that  
I believe rendered it useless

Notice is hereby given that an application will be made by or on behalf of the said Kenneth Farrell to the County Court, at the Sessions to be held on the Seventh day of June next, at Loughrea in and for the Division of Loughrea and County of Galway for compensation for the loss sustained by the said Kenneth Farrell by reason of the criminal injury done the said property as aforesaid, and that the said application will be made in pursuance of the 135 section of the Grand Jury (Ireland) Act, 1836, and any Act extending same, and of the Local Government (Ireland) Act, 1898, and that the said compensation may be levied off the said County, or such County or other District, Parish, Townland, or Denomination thereof as the County Court Judge shall direct.
