Dear Sir,

On the 24th of April last, the Ballinard Co-operative Creamery Co. Ballinard, Tipperary, dispatched eight boxes of butter to Kingsbridge for Daniel Murphy. Dublin

I have been able to trace five of these boxes but the remaining three, weighing in all 84 pounds, would appear to have been availed of by the Military, who were at that time in complete occupation of the Station premises.

A claim of £6 has been made on the Company for the value of the butter (at 160/= per cwt) and I shall be glad to have a remittance of that sum at your earliest convenience.
