

Dear Sir.

I am enclosing you the account for a second-hand Bar-Lock which was on loan with Messrs. Curtis & Sons, Abbey Street, at the time of the outbreak, and, unfortunately, I overlooked sending the claim in before now. I am not quite if Curtis & Sons have included the machine in claim. They may not have done so as it was not their property, and it was only lent to them while we were repairing one of theirs. Mr. Robert Kidney mentioned to me that he thought perhaps you might be still able to deal with the matter, and if possible get the claim settled.
