re Claim F.W. Higginbotham No. 6894.

Mr Higginbotham's claim is for 62 sets of plans and he forwards letters from 59 Clients with reference thereto. Most of the plans were for Factories and Estates, and embraced development schemes not fully carried out. After a complete examination of the claim, as far as we can see, Mr Higginbotham will be at considerable loss in the re-production of these plans. The properties will have to be surveyed and measured by Mr Higginbotham and his Assistants, and any plans which may not be necessary have eliminated from the list. From the Claimant's standpoint it is necessary to put a sum opposite each set of plans so that he will know how he stands with his clients. These plans were not originally included in Mr Higginbotham's claim No. 5431 which were plans for work in course of actual progress. Many of the plans now claimed for embraced work held up in consequence of the War, such as the Malahide Reclamation scheme which was passed by the Treasury. No fees were ever paid on foot of Claimants labour on the scheme.

We understand Mr Higginbotham originally made an application to the Committee in connection with his plans, not knowing in what position he stood with regard to them. There are three which require special attention No.6 No.11 & No.17.

In the case of No.6, Alex Thom & Co, Mr Higginbotham had the whole plans of the premises which were of a somewhat complicated description. Messrs Thom required these plans in connection with their claim and the plans had to be re-produced.

Messrs Thom & Co claimed that Mr Higginbotham should provide them at his own expense as they were in his keeping.

The same remarks apply to Nos.11 & 17.

We enclose schedule with the amounts which we think fairly represent the costs of re-producing plans, which from the evidence appear necessary to be re-produced, or have been.

Some few clients are paying half and the other half only has been claimed By Mr Higginbotham.

There were of course hundreds of plans destroyed for which no claim has been made. The only plans claimed for are those for properties, the owners of which are pressing for the re-production of them.
