1. In the month of April 1916 I used in my possession in the hire purchase system a bicycle the property of *Mr Fitz Gerald St Stephen Green* in which I had paid £1-13-0
2. That on the 26 day of April 1916 I had the bicycle with me at *Sackville St* I was surrounded by rebels & I save my life had to run amongst the crowd leaving the bicycle behind me -
3. I have never seen the bicycle since & I have I can be sure with any accuracy of it -
