

He informs me that amongst other items were four original unpublished Monologues which would be worth at least £2:2:0 each and Nineteen Folk Poems which were also unpublished and which unfortunately, as is also the case with the Monologues, Mr MacGarvey cannot contains reproduce from memory and of which he has no other record and he values these at 10/6 each at the very lowest, as he has been in the habit of obtaining as much as £1:1:0 each for short Poems of this
