Dear Sir,

We received a communication from the under secretary re above claim wherein was stated that a sum of £7. 9. 6. had been provisionally approved of for damages to the above premises. On looking through our imaks papers it appears that an error was made in the blue form supplied to you. It appears that a claim for damage to the walls and paper of the bed-room on 2nd floor was put on the blue form as amounting to 3/-. This was an error and should have been £3 per estimate supplied to you with the blue form. We would be much obliged if you would kindly have this matter rectified when I take it the amount to be approved by you be £92 17. 6. There is a claim for damage to the factory glass-roof overhead for which an estimate has been sent in amounting to 7/6. In the provisional sum approved of this was apparently overlooked. We would thank you to rectify this error and notify the under Secretary of same.
