Sir,

We beg leave to apply for £35 compensation for Bank notes lost or destroyed in Dublin on Easter Monday last as a result of the Rebellion. We have been seeking compensation since the loss occurred from the P.O. Authorities. Recently they paid us £5, and suggested that we apply to your Committee for the balance of the loss viz £35. We enclose two letters on the subject from the G.P.O. & the I.A.O.S. and we sincerely hope that you will not debar our claim as being too late or we were entirely ignorant of the procedure to be followed and were pinning our faith on the G.P.O.
