Dear Sir,

On the 27th. ulto, we wrote to Messrs. James Hartly & Co. Ltd.,
 of North Quay, Eastern Basin, London Docks, E. as follows:-

"We handed to you on April 10th, ten bags of Steel Wool consigned
 to Messrs. F. W. Woolworth & Co. Ltd. of 66/67 Grafton Street, Dublin.
 They advise us this morning that only 8 bags have been received. Please
 have the two remaining bags delivered and advise us that this has been
 done."

They reply us follows:-

"In regard to your letter of the 27th. ulto, we regret 2 Bags
 were looted from the Dublin Store during the recent rebellion in
 Ireland, and we shall be glad if you will submit claim to R.J.Kidney, Esq.
 Secretary, Dublin Fire & Property Losses Association, 1916, 12 College
 Green, Dublin."
