Damages on the 24 & 25 April 1916

On these 2 days this house was in occupation of the Volunteers till the evening of the 25th: A barricade was made of the furniture bedding etc, pianos & other pieces of furniture, the Kitchen door was broken in, & the bolt &c and lock forcibly opened. The 'Clothes' line, poles &c even were all taken from the garden for a barricade of wire across the M.G.W. Railway bridge at Cabra Road. This was used in conjunction with the Railway Telegraph wires. Poles were taken away and a ladder and trestle work.

The family and servants numbering 9 were ordered away at midday on Monday and had to reside at Norfolk Road, off St Peter Road, till Tuesday night. A new fender was smashed and in removing the piano several things were knocked down broken or otherwise damaged - including a pair of Field glasses, tongs were broken, fancy pots, baby car, chairs, glasses. Damage was caused in almost every room of the house. Even 2½ dozen ^{empty} bottles in the Scullery were taken out and smashed on Cabra Bridge: At a reasonable estimate the total value of the injury and loss suffered and damage caused by the occupation of this house would be from £18 to £20. All the furniture and bedding was backed about and it took until the following Wednesday night to have all the furniture barricading the house removed from the doors and windows =
