Dear Madam,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 19th inst. forwarding estimate for making good damage done to the rear wall of 18 Fitzwilliam Place during the disturbances of April - May 1916. In reply I beg to say that the latest date for intimating claims to the Property Loss Committee, as intimated in all the Dublin daily papers, was 12th August 1916. The Committee has long since sent its report to the Government regarding all claims received and has closed its list. I regret therefore that nothing can now be done in this case.
