## re claim of Mr Louis Wine.

Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 20th instant,

I beg to say that there is no record of any claim having
been received by the Property Losses Committee from or on
behalf of Mr Louis Wine, 31/32 Grafton Street, Dublin,
and there is no likelihood that such a claim if lodged
would have been mislaid here.

It was well known that practically all the claims sent to the Committee had been disposed of by December last, and it is unfortunate that no mention of this case should be made till now - nearly six months after the Committee had sent its final report to the Goven ment and thereby ceased to exist.

It is regretted that nothing can now be done in the matter.



On the 6th July 1916, I forwarded to you in the name of "Kennedy & Gray" several claims amongst which was one in the name of Mr. Louis Wine, 31/2 Grafton Street, for a broken Plate Glass Window enclosing estimate for replacement and giving credit for Salvage. It amounted to £10/4/7. nett.

On the 7th July D received a formal acknowledgement headed -

m 2080

"re Claims of Mrs.F.Crofts & Others." but it appears nothing has since been heard of Mr. Wine's Claim. The broken window in Grafton Street is still to be seen, and if the papers have been lost or mislaid, I would respectfully suggest that the matter should receive your kind consideration as it is no fault of Mr. Wines, and was one of the few claims that admitted of no question or discussion.
