Dear Mr. Archdeacon,

Premises - 44 North King St.

We have now made a careful examination of this building and send you herewith our Valuation of the damage done by the Sinn Feiners during the rebellion.

The upper part of the House was in a state of disrepair before the Rebels took possession, the timber work of
the windows etc. being much decayed, and the floors, walls and
roofs also needed repair. We have had to take this fact into
consideration and have only noted those items of damage which
were obviously done during the time the house was occupied by
the Rebels. As the claim is not one in respect of fire, the
blue forms which you left with us are not suitable, and we have
therefore prepared the Valuation in the usual way and return
the forms herewith. The Valuation should be sent to the
Secretary, Property Losses Committee, 51 St. Stephen's Green
Dubline, and he will hand the claim to the Assessors appointed
by the Government. If any further information is required by
Assessors we shall of course be glad to give it.
