Dear Sir,

Claim, 44, Nth. King's Street.

Referring to the valuation of damage to the above premises which we made on behalf of our client the Venble. the Archdeacon of Dublin and which is being examined by your Assessor Mr. Kennedy. There is an item in this valuation for replacing a large number of bricks which have been damaged by ~~the rebels~~ ^{bullets}, and we priced this item on the assumption that the work would be done from ladders, but as we understand that, in order to comply with the requirements of the Corporation, a hoarding and scaffolding would be necessary for the work, we beg to submit a supplemental claim as follows to cover the cost of the work:-

Item. Erect hoarding 40 feet long with two 6 feet returns and 1 door..... £7. 0. 0.

Item. Erect scaffolding to both fronts of building Cutting and making good putlog holes..... 10. 0. 0.

£17. 0. 0.
