Dear Sir,

I enclose herewith my application on behalf of ANNE LYNCH & Co. for compensation in respect of losses sustained during disturbances in April last.

I have filled in the two forms (original and copy), giving details of each section of the claim on a separate sheet.

With regard to Stock in Retail Shop, Iregret that I cannot give it direct from & stock book as I have done with the Store Stock. Our system is to charge all goods to the Shop at full retail prices, checking the stock every Monday morning, debiting the Shop with all goods delivered to it and giving it credit for cash paid to Office and for goods sold on credit. Then the balance should agree pretty closely with the stock on hand.

Our calculations in this case are based on the Stock Sheet for the week ended April 8th, 1916, the sheet for April 15th having disappeared in the locting.

I enclose also a certified copy of each of the London & Lancashire Fire Policies and of the respective receipts for the last payment of Premium on each policy. I send also the original policy (5335732) of the Alliance Assurance Co. Ltd., covering Consequential Damages; also original Policy (12067) of the British & Irish Plate Glass Insurance Co., with, in each case, the receipt for payment of last premium.

I trust you will find Claim and Details clear and complete.
