Interests in the buildings

The building containing the property claimed for was occupied on the ground floor by Carlisle & Clegg as Wholesale Wall Paper Showrooms, the upper portion being used as offices some of which were in occupation of Messrs. Maunsel, with whom, in July 1915, the Claimants entered into an arrangement to stock their publications on sale or return. I have gone into the items with Mr. Roberts, of Messrs. Maunsel, now doing business at 50, Lower Baggot St. It is impossible to vouch the various items, but he has stated that Messrs. Allen & Unwin have complete details of the publications in the premises at the time of the outbreak. Some of the items would never have been utilised, and were really only fit for waste paper, and under these circumstances I have reduced the claim by one-third, which is, I consider, reasonable.



We have now filled in the desired particulars of our claim for damages caused during the disturbances on the 24th April 1916 and the following days.

Our claim is largely in respect of single copies of our current publications held for us by Messrs Maunsel & Co. Ltd. at 96 Middle Abbey Street, Dublin.

It is extremely difficult to give any figure as representing the actual cost of these books. In many cases the type has been distributed, and the "cost" of reprinting a single copy might be two or three hundred times the published price.

We have gone into the matter very fully, and feel that it would be reasonable to put the cost at 20 per cent below the Trade price at which we valued the books at the time of destruction. This is the basis on which they were insured.
