Interests in the buildings

The other items of claim may be written down in the same proportion: each item is unsatisfactory. The Camera, for instance, is in Claimant's brother's premises at RathminesRoad.

The building items in the claim must be ruled through. Claimant has no interest therein, being only a yearly
