Interests in the buildings

The Claimant occupies the top storey of the building 1, Wellington Quay, the ground floor being used by T. P. & R. Goodbody as Wholesale Tobacco Warehouse. (See Claim 990). It would appear that the Military entered these premises and were on the roof for some days. Regarding the first three items of Claim, for seven glass cases - £7. 2. 0., I find that there were only five cases, two of which have been repaired by Messrs. Dockrell for the sum of 9/9 - see dockets attached which I obtained. Allowing then at this price for three others - say 15/- - the total claim for the cases could only be £1. 4. 9. The other items of claim may be written down in the same proportion: each item is unsatisfactory. The Camera, for instance, is in Claimant's brother's premises at Rathmines Road. The building items in the claim must be ruled through. Claimant has no interest therein, being only a yearly tenant. I consider £9 ample compensation.




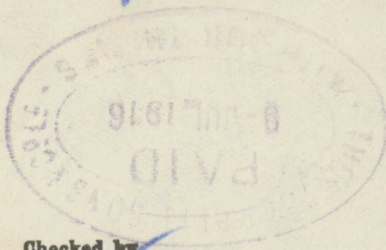
