Mary Byrne now residing at 12 Canac Ter High 18 Kulmacahamin the City of Dublin do hereby solemnly and sincerely declare that on or about the 24 day of April & 1916, damage was done to the undermentioned Property, namely :- * 1 Trunk of Exhact looted while awaiting delivery at west Tedearth north u and such damage was occasioned to the best of my belief by** losting ** Here cause of damage And 1 We further declare that the Property and Articles specified on the other side were so destroyed or damaged; that the Cost Price of same was as shown in each case; that at the time of the destruction or damage they were respectively of the Values specified under the head "Value of Property at time of Destruction or Damage"; and that, in consequence of such destruction or damage, claim is hereby made for the sums specified under the head "Amount Claimed"; that the Claim is made by and that no person is interested in the said property except! Myself and that it is not insured by me or any other person, § except as follows, namely:— And We make this solemn Declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true, and by virtue of the provisions of the Statutory Declarations Act, 1835. Made and subscribed the 29K Stephens Green in the said City, County, before me, a Justice of the Peace for the said
