I am the principal in it, and acting as Secretary of the Irish Commercial Travellers Association, I had as the principal asset of the appointment, the almost exclusive use of the two splendid offices they had at 33 Lr Abbey Street. The present Claim is a copy of the one sent in to the Fire & Losses Property Assn, under circumstances detailed on the Claim itself, and also on the Claim of the Travellers Assn.

Apart from the actual losses I sustained by the Fires, the contingent losses are incalculable, owing to the fact that the Samples destroyed were American, and of stuff whose duplicate samples, by the time they would reach us, would have missed their Market for another year.
