I have investigated this claim. The House (situate in the best locality in Dublin) suffered considerable damage by rifle fire during the insurrection. The Contract for repairs was given to the Firm of Maguire & Gatchell Ltd. and whilst their charges might be considered somewhat high, I beg to recommend that the claim be admitted as I found on examination that there was considerable damage done that was not claimed for.


