The Claim in this case is for personal property, but is, I am of opinion, inflated. I met Mr. Purcell at his private residence, and found that the property was all either destroyed or looted, the premises having been badly damaged during the Rebellion. The Claimant could not give exact details to substantiate his claim, but as he is an old man of eighty years of age I did not press the matter. I am inclined to think that the clothing was brought in by Claimant for disposal to the poor men who gather at this Institute for meals, but Claimant would not admit this.
